## Case Summary:

Mark-room issue at the port side finishing mark.

## Procedural Matters:

1. During the hearing it was learnt that GRE-217949 was also involved in the incident and may have broken a rule.
2. The jury protested GRE-217949 (Case 18) under RRS 60.3(a)(2).
3. The hearing of Case 14 was recommenced after making GRE-217949 as a party.

## Facts Found:

1. The wind was $8-10$ knots and the water was choppy.
2. During the last leg of the race, ITA- 220094 and GRE- 213828 were reaching towards the finishing line, both on port tack.
3. When ITA-220094 entered the zone of the port end finishing mark, she was overlapped to windward and inside of GRE-213828.
4. At the zone, GRE-217949 was overlapped to leeward and outside of GRE-213828.
5. The gap between GRE-217949 and GRE-213828 was around 5 m .
6. While passing the finishing mark, the gap between ITA-220094 and GRE-213828 was less than 1 m .
7. The port side of the hull of ITA-220094 made contact with the starboard stern of the finishing mark (RC vessel).
8. There was a scratch of around 1 m due to the contact.
9. No boat took a penalty.

## Conclusion \& Rules:

1. GRE-213828 outside overlapped at the zone failed to give ITA-220094 mark-room, and broke RRS 18.2(b).
2. ITA-220094 touched the finsihing mark and broke RRS 31.
3. Since ITA-220094 broke RRS 31 while she was sailing within the mark-room to which she was entitled, she is exonerated under RRS 43.1(b) for this breach.
