Facts Found:

1. Near mark 4S (inner loop), strong winds

2. ESP-213379 and SUI both sailing on starboard tack on the run

3. SUI-220126, the first boat to enter the zone, was clear ahead of ESP-213379.

4. SUI-220126 capsized to leeward of mark 4s.

5. While rounding between the mark and SUI-220126, contact occurred between ESP-213379 port first quarter and SUI-220126 hull.

6. ESP-213379 mainsheet got entangled with SUI-220126 bow and capsized

7. ESP-213379 sail suffered a rib of less than 10cm above its sail numbers and SUI-220126 at his center board a dent of less then 1cm² on the lower tearing edge

8. ESP-213379 retired.

9. SUI-220126 continued racing and finished.

Conclusion & Rules:

1. ESP-213379 failed to avoid SUI-220126 who was capsized, even though it was possible. ESP-213379 broke RRS 22.

2. ESP-213379 did not avoid contact when it was reasonably possible, and broke RRS 14.

3. It was not reasonably possible for SUI-220126 the right-of-way boat to avoid contact with ESP-213379 when it was clear that SUI-220126 was not keeping clear. SUI-220126 did not break RRS 14.

4. ESP-213379 place in race 3 was made significantly worse through her own fault. Therefore, the requirements for redress in RRS 62.1 are not met

5. SUI-220126 place in race 3 was not made significantly worse by the physical damage. Therefore, the requirements for redress in RRS 62.1 are not met.
