Case Summary:

Request for redress against race committee omission.

Procedural Matters:

The panel of the International Jury was composed in accordance with RRS N.1.4 (b).

Facts Found:

- 1. The wind was around 20 knots, there were 0.5m waves and the current was in the direction of the wind
- 2. BUL 219618 was approaching mark 1 from above the layline, sailing on a narrow reach on starboard tack.
- 3. BUL 219618 noticed that mark 1 was moving slightly.
- 4. When BUL 219618 was rounding mark 1 at a distance of less than 0.5 meter.
- 5. BUL 219618's port guarter touched the mark and he capsized.
- BUL 219618 recovered from the capsize, took a one-turn penalty and continued to sail.
- 7. At the time of the incident, BUL 219618 was lying in 9th position.
- 8. After the one-turn penalty when BUL 219618 resumed sailing, she finished in 21st position.

Conclusion & Rules:

- 1. BUL 219618 touched mark 1 and broke RRS 31.
- 2. By taking a one-turn penalty BUL 219618 exonerated herself in accordance with RRS 44.1.
- 3. The mark moving slightly is normal under the given wind and sea conditions. There was neither an improper action nor omission of the race committee
- 4. BUL 219618's score in race 4 was worsened by her own fault. Therefore, the requirements for redress in RRS 62.1(a) are not met.
