Case Summary:

Mark room at pin end.

Procedural Matters:

Facts Found:

- 1. ITA 218264 to windward and GER 221100 to leeward, overlapped on starboard and close hauled, aproached the pin end of the finishing line on a course not fetching it.
- 2. GER 221100 half boat length ahead.
- 3. Both boats entered the zone.
- 4. GER 221100 tacked to port, bore away and passed behind ITA 218264.
- 5. GER 221100 luffed head to wind.
- 6. At the same time, ITA 218264 passed head to wind to tack, establishing windward overlap.
- 7. GER 221100 bore away to avoid ITA 218264 before ITA 218264 completed the tack.
- 8. No collisions.
- 9. No penalty taken.

Conclusion & Rules:

- 1. ITA 218264 as inside overlapped boat was entitled to mark room under RRS 18.2(a).
- 2. GER 221100 gave mark room to ITA 218264.
- 3. After passing head to wind and before being on a close hauled course, ITA 218264 failed to keep clear of GER 221100 and broke RRS 13.
- 4. Since ITA 218264 broke RRS 13 while she was sailing within the mark room to which she was entitled, she was exonerated under RRS 43.1(b) for this breach.
