Case Summary:

Redress for wind shift in race 1.

Procedural Matters:

Panel of the International Jury, in accordance with N1.4(b), and the parties were properly informed. Observers: Michalina Wroblewska and Kasia Goralska, of the jury

Facts Found:

1. Race 1, Boats were racing on leg 3, nearing the downwind gate, when there was a wind shift of 60-70 degrees to the right

2. Charlie with a green board was displayed at the downwind gate

3. After 10 boats rounded the downwind gate, the windward mark was replaced, 60 degrees to the right

4. USA and FIN both stated to have lost 20-30 places

5. All boats finished the race.

Conclusion & Rules: -

1. When Charlie was displayed the next mark was not yet in place, however it was not required to, in accordance with RRS 33

2. The race committee may abandon a race when the race is directly affecting the fairness of the competition, in accordance with RRS 32.1, however it is not obligated to do so.

3. There was no error or omission by the race committee, therefore the requirements for redress, 62.1(a), are not met.
