Case Summary:

Failure to comply with sailing instructions pertaining to safety, by a support person.

Procedural Matters:

All the boats supported by the support person were notified of the hearing, but the following boats did not attend the hearing:-

ISR 199506, ISR 192666, ISR 200785, ISR 204623, ISR 202381, ISR 204625, ISR 206846, ISR 207414, ISR 204626.

The hearing proceeded in the absence of the above parties, in accordance with rule 63.3(b).

The hearing was heard in accordance with RRS N1.4(b), and the parties were properly informed.

Facts Found:

- 1. Coach No 83, Liav Weiss, was spotted in the race area on 14 July and again on 15 July not having a kill-cord attached while the engine was running.
- 2. On July 14, Mr. Weis was given an on the water warning.
- 3. SI 22.1 requires support persons to comply with the Support Vessel Regulations.
- 4. NoR Attachment 2 para 3.2 requires that the kill cord be used at all times when the engine is running.

Conclusion & Rules:

By not having the kill cord attached while the engine was running, Coach No 83 failed to comply with SI 22.1 and NoR Attachment 2 para 3.2.

Decision:

SI 22.1 applies, as well as Jury policy D3, level 4. However, because this event is a youth event in which his sailors may need assistance other than coaching, Mr Weiss is ordered to anchor his vessel 200 meters below the starting line from the time the first orange flag of the day is hoisted, until all races are done for the day of Sunday 16th.

ISR 199506, ISR 192666, ISR 200785, ISR 204623, ISR 202381, ISR 204625, ISR 206846, ISR 207414, ISR 204626 are warned that if their coach, Mr. Weiss, infringes any rule again, they may be also penalized.

Short Decision: Decision Date Decision Time

Mr Weiss is ordered to anchor his vessel 200 meters below the starting line from the time the first orange flag of the day is hoisted, until all races are done for the day of Sunday 16th.

His sailors are warned that if their coach, Mr. Weiss, infringes any rule again, they may be also penalized.
