UFD request for redress

Procedural Matters:

The hearing was heard by a panel of three in accordance with RRS N1.4(b).

The protest time limit was 15:20. The request was submitted at 15:44. Immediately after getting ashore, FRA 203855 checked the results, checked the recordings with the race committee, and submitted his request.

FRA 203855 failed to deliver the request for redress within the protest time limit or two hours after the incident, as required by RRS 62.2. However, there was good reason for the protest committee to extend the time limit under RRS 62.2.

Facts Found: -

- 1. The race committee displayed flag U as preparatory signal in the starting procedure in question.
- 2. The race committee identified FRA 203855 in the triangle formed by the ends of the starting line and the first mark within the last two seconds to her starting signal.
- 3. The race committee scored FRA 203855 UFD in race 2.

Conclusion & Rules:

There was neither an improper action nor omission of the race committee. Therefore, the requirements for redress in RRS 62.1(a) are not met.

Redress is not given.
