Case Summary:

Procedural Matters: -

Marton Beliczay (jury member) Enrico Strazzera (coach of HUN) attended the hearing as observers.

HUN 211551 provided video evidence of the incident

Facts Found:

- 1. Leg 1, 8 boat lengths from the top mark. Wind 5 to 6 knots and large swells
- 2. NED 210407 was on starboard and HUN 211551 on port on converging courses.
- 3. When there were two boat lengths between the boats, HUN 211551 bore away a few degrees as NED 210407 luffed past head to wind.
- 4. HUN 211551 then luffed up as NED 210407 reached a closed-hauled course on port, with NED 210407 half a boat length clear ahead and half a boat length to leeward of HUN 211551.
- 5. No contact and no penalty taken.

Conclusion & Rules:

- 1. After passing head to wind and before being on a close-hauled course, NED 210407 kept clear of HUN 211551 as required by RRS 13.
- 2. When acquiring right of way through her own actions, NED 210407 initially gave HUN 211551 room to keep clear, as required by RRS 15.
- 3. HUN 211551 clear astern kept clear of NED 210407 clear ahead, as required by RRS 12.
