# **Case Summary:**

### **Procedural Matters:**

Hearing 59 was heard together with hearing 60 in accordance with rule 63.2 since both hearings arose from the same incident.

## Facts Found:

- 1. CYP 212432 and CRO 212013 claimed that the international jury acted improperly in finding facts 3 and 4 of case 54 and in deciding to abandon the race.
- 2. The international jury found the facts in case 54 according to rule 63.6. The international jury took evidence from the testimonies of the parties and witnesses, and video evidence provided by the witnesses.
- 3. Not only GER 211241 but also other boats were affected by the omission of the race committee. It was not possible for the international jury to identify those boats.
- 4. The international jury sought for as fair an arrangement as possible. The international jury considered that abandoning race F1 of the ILCA 7 Gold fleet was as fair an arrangement as possible for all boats affected, whether or not they asked for redress.
- 5. After considering all the evidence the international jury was not in doubt about the facts or probable results of the arrangement decided.

# Conclusion & Rules: -

1. There was neither an improper action nor omission of the internstional jury. Therefore, the requirements for redress in RRS 62.1(a) are not met.
