Case Summary:

Procedural Matters: -

- 1. Hearing No. 63 was heard together with Hearing No. 65 in accordance with RRS 63.2 since both hearings arose from the same incident.
- 2. NOR 217214 provided video evidence

Facts Found: -

- 1. The Uniform flag was used as a preparatory signal for race F3 of the ILCA 7 Gold fleet.
- 2. During the last 2 seconds before the starting signal, the race committee identified 5 boats in the triangle formed by the ends of the starting line and the first mark.
- 3. The race committee did not observe other boats in the triangle formed by the ends of the starting line and the first mark.
- 4. The race committee did not signal a general recall.
- 5. The race committee later determined that 3 of the identified sail numbers were not found in the entry list.

Conclusion & Rules:

- 1. As the race committee believed it identified all boats that broke rule 30.3, not signaling a general recall was not an improper omission.
- 2. There was neither an improper action nor an omission of the race committee. Therefore, the requirements for redress in RRS 62.1(a) are not met.
