Case Summary:

Procedural Matters:

1. Hearing No. 63 was heard together with Hearing No. 65 in accordance with RRS 63.2 since both hearings arose from the same incident.
2. NOR 217214 provided video evidence

Facts Found:

1. The Uniform flag was used as a preparatory signal for race F3 of the ILCA 7 Gold fleet.
2. During the last 2 seconds before the starting signal, the race committee identified 5 boats in the triangle formed by the ends of the starting line and the first mark.
3. The race committee did not observe other boats in the triangle formed by the ends of the starting line and the first mark.
4. The race committee did not signal a general recall.
5. The race committee later determined that 3 of the identified sail numbers were not found in the entry list.

Conclusion & Rules:

1. As the race committee believed it identified all boats that broke rule 30.3, not signaling a general recall was not an improper omission.
2. There was neither an improper action nor an omission of the race committee. Therefore, the requirements for redress in RRS 62.1(a) are not met.
