Delete

6.2 [DP] [NP] A boat shall not leave the shore until flag G (with one sound signal) is displayed. The warning signal will be made not be less than 45 minutes after flag G is displayed.

6.3 When flag AP is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than 45 minutes' in the race signal AP. This changes RRS Race Signals.

Replace by

6.2 Flag G displayed with two sounds (one when removed) means "No boat shall go afloat until this signal is removed. The first warning signal will be made not less than 60 minutes after flag G is removed.

6.3 When flag AP is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than 60 minutes' in the race signal AP.

20.5 When the race committee displays flag V with repetitive sounds, all official and support vessels shall monitor the race committee VHF 73 channel for instructions and assist in search and rescue operations.

Replace by

20.5 When the race committee displays flag V with repetitive sounds, all official and support vessels shall monitor the race committee VHF 8 channel for instructions and assist in search and rescue operations.
