Case Summary:

Procedural Matters:

Claudia Sobral acted as translator for ESP 219335.

Facts Found:

SLO 207288 did not hail "Protest".

The damage on SLO 207288 was a crack 3 to 4cm long on the back of the rudder, just above the waterline

Conclusion & Rules:

The damage did not reduce the safety of the crew.

The damage did impact the boat's sailing performance but not in a significant way

The cost of repairing the damage will not be a significant amount relative to the market value of the boat

The value of the boat after repairing the damage will not be significantly diminished

Following WS Case 141, the damage is not serious.

SLO 207288 failed to inform ESP 219335 of her intention to protest as required by RRS 61.1(a).
